

## **Important Information about the Tour of Broad River Correctional Facility**

                                     2. Thursday, November 29th, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. (Ben Meade)

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: 4460 Broad River Road, Columbia, SC 29210

From Columbia: Take I-26. Take the St. Andrews East Exit, Exit 106B. Turn Right on St. Andrews Road. Take a left onto Broad River Road. Broad River Correctional Facility will be about a mile down on the right.

From I-20. Take the Broad River Road Exit, Exit 65. Go Northwest on Broad River Road. If you are going the right direction, you will pass an Applebee's on your right. Follow Broad River for about 2.5 miles. Broad River Correctional Facility will be on your right.

Main Entrance: Once you entered the Broad River complex you will see a white guard booth. Go past this booth and bear right (past gas station). Turn right where you see the sign "Broad River Correction Institute". In less than one mile you will see a security house which is the entrance to the facility. Only bring approved ID and car keys into facility, make sure you do not have any unapproved products on your keychain (e.g. pepper spray).

## **Important Information about the Tour of Broad River Correctional Facility**

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Do not enter the administration building until we have all arrived.

If you are not ready to enter the facility at 8:45 am you will be excluded from the tour.

You must bring a state-issued picture ID (i.e., a driver's license). You will need to leave your IDs at the control room desk when you enter the prison and pick them up when you leave.

Do not bring any purses, book bags, backpacks, etc. on the tour. These will not be allowed inside the prison. Please lock them in your car or leave them at home. Do not bring anything with you that could be construed as a weapon. No mace or pepper spray, no knives, no batons, not even nail clippers. You may bring keys into the prison (such as car keys), but be sure that you do not have any weapons on your key ring.

### DRESS CODE:

The Center has a dress code that must be followed. If our tour guide judges that you are not dressed appropriately, you will not be allowed to go on the tour.

For men, you also may not wear shorts or jeans. Casual pants are fine. Your shirt must have a collar. No baseball caps.

For women, you may not wear a skirt or dress that falls more than one inch above the knee. You also may not wear shorts or jeans. (I recommend wearing pants.) Do not wear a revealing shirt--be sure that it covers your shoulders and stomach. No baseball caps.

There are extra criteria for jewelry, specifically please follow these:

- ❖ No bracelets or anklets are allowed
- ❖ Only 1 pair of earrings allowed
- ❖ 1 wedding ring (no other rings allowed)
- ❖ 1 medical bracelet allowed
- ❖ 1 religious medallion around neck (no other necklaces allowed)

### WHAT NOT TO HAVE IN YOUR CAR:

Before you drive to the Center, please remove any weapons or drugs from your car. Your car is subject to search while you are on the prison property. Although it is unlikely that your car will be searched, if you are found to have any of these things in your car, you may be cited for bringing contraband onto prison property. Also, be sure to lock your car after you park.
